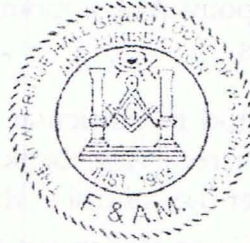



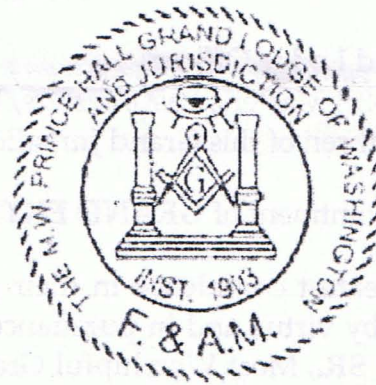
These appointments are in accordance with:

- a) **Article 13, Powers of the Grand Master**, and in particular **Article 13:12** granting the Grand Master the power to appoint **ALL** appointed grand lodge officers and appoint **ALL** committees and to fill vacancies.
- b) **Title 61, Comptroller Board**, and in particular **Section 61.02:01.**, the Comptroller Board shall be directly responsible for receiving, banking, investing, disbursing, and budgeting all monies belonging to or under the control of the Grand Lodge.
