Right Worshipful (R.W.) Gregory Dorail Wraggs was the youngest of nine children born to the Late Roy Haynes and Maggie Holmes in Louisville, Mississippi on February 26, 1966.

After graduating from Louisville High School in 1984, he enlisted into the U.S. Army where he served for over twenty years retiring in June 2005. While serving on active duty he received his degree with Pierce College and recently received another degree in December 2010. His present occupation is with the U.S. Government in Bremerton. He is a member of Shiloh Baptist Church in Tacoma, Washington.

R.W. Wraggs has a very involved Masonic career to date. His Masonic career began in 1988 when he was initiated, passed and raised to the sublime degree of a Master Mason in Rising Star #18 in Lawton, Oklahoma.

He demitted into Pride of Washington #98, Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Washington where he is a Chartered member. R.W. Wraggs was appointed Junior Deacon, elected Treasurer and Senior Warden and eventually in 1997 elected to the oriental chair as Worshipful Master.

Continuing his Masonic career in the Washington Jurisdiction, he has served as District Deputy Grand Master #11 (2002- 2003), Special District Deputy Grand Master (2003-2004), District Deputy Grand Master #2 (2006-2008), Grand Lecturer (2008-2010), Grand Junior Warden (2009-2010) and chaired and served on a number of Grand Lodge Committees.

He currently serves in the position of Grand Senior Warden for the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge, Washington and Jurisdiction.

R.W. Wraggs joined Scottish Rite Masonry in 1995 by becoming a member of Cascadian Consistory #75; afterward demitted into Capital City Consistory #106 where he is a Past Commander-in-Chief.

He has served as Thrice Potent Master; a Past Potentate of Yemen Temple #152 (A.E.A.O.N.M.S.); a past High Priest of William L. Gardner Chapter #4 who under his leadership was Chapter of the Year (2002).

May 2009 R.W. Wraggs received his last degree in Masonry by being coronated a Grand Inspectors General, 33^o in Rochester, New York.

He is married to the lovely Kim S. Wraggs and has 5 children--4 adults and 1 teenager; Ticara (27), Shawnta (26), Devonte (20), Qwaknesa (20) Greg Jr. (17). They are blessed with three grandchildren.
