Subj: Ordering and Replacement of GL Aprons/Collars

All Greetings

The Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge, State of Washington, and Jurisdiction Grand Trustees will meet to discuss the replacement and ordering of Grand Lodge aprons or collars.

We will meet with Grand Master and get his approval. Then will submit it to the Comptroller Board they will approve it; then they will pass it on to Grand Secretary for ordering. It is also our job to observe and evaluate the aprons and collars to see if they warrant replacement.

If you are no longer an elected or appointed Grand Lodge officer, it is your responsibility to forward the apron and/or collar Grand Trustee Board and not to someone else to give to us. Again, it is your responsibility. Failure to do this will make you financially responsible and liable.

At this year's upcoming Grand session, all elected and appointed Grand Lodge Officers will be required to sign for their aprons and/or collars.
