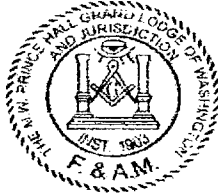

Greeting from the office of the Grand Junior Warden,

First giving honor to God, then my brothers I want to thank you for the trust you had in me by electing me to service as your Grand Junior Warden. I stand before you on the shoulders of Giants, of those who have went before me in this seat. Therefore, it is my job to call the craft for refreshment to labor to render an account of my stewardship as your Grand Junior Warden for the Masonic year from July 2008 through June 2009. It is with the deepest thanks that I admit that I would not have been able to carry out the duties of this office as Grand Junior Warden without the support of my loving wife Lydia, understanding kids and grand kids, our Most Worshipful Grand Master and each of you. To all of them and each of you I say: **Thank you.**

This year went by rapidly, as it seems just yesterday we were here and I was being installed as your Grand Junior Warden at our 105th Annual session. In accordance with my responsibilities I am to assist the Most Worshipful Grand Master in the area of Youth and Education. I stated then that I would support the Most Worshipful Grand Master and this Grand Lodge on each and every occasion. My Brothers, I have attempted to do so as I stated I would. To that end I have traveled with Most Worshipful Grand Master Anthony every place he has went when possible. I have also traveled throughout the jurisdiction when requested. An example of this is my trip to Korea where I was the guest speaker for their 15th Anniversary. The opportunity that these visits forwarded me was very rewarding and a learning experience.

In addition to being the fourth executive officer of this great jurisdiction, I have the responsibility for the Knights of Pythagoras Program, the Scholarship Program, and the Promenade Ball that we will be attending tonight. I am also the Second Vice Chairperson of the Grand Entertainment committee. With that I am privileged to come before you to render an account of my activities and accomplishments over the past twelve months.

The Knights of Pythagoras Program has made some real significant progress in that we set many goals and then worked toward those goals. Our primary and most important goal for the year was to get the administrative side of the Knights of Pythagoras together. Prior to this year the Grand Junior Wardens worked hard with the Knights of Pythagoras Programs, and my hat is off to them for the great work they did. To that end the first thing I did was call PGM Gil Tyler of the Virginia Jurisdiction. He is the Supreme Master Knight and each jurisdiction indirectly falls under his overview. Education and Scholarships is another part of my job that has great responsibility. The first thing I want to inform the body is that all students that were awarded scholarships last year have been paid. I am proud to announce that the education and scholarship program for 2007-2008 had been officially completed. We had 29 applications for scholarships this year 2008-2009. I want to thank GSW Torrance for the packet he passed on to me from last year. With minor changes to the packets and a great committee we got the job done. Of the 29 that applied we approved 24 students for scholarships. If they met all of the requirements they were approved and awarded a scholarship. To my knowledge 24 is a record number of scholarships awarded by this Grand Lodge. The full details of the scholarships and names of the students that were awarded will be on the Education and Scholarship report.

Lastly, in my capacity as Second Vice Chairperson of the Grand Entertainment Committee, it has been an eye opener. I want to thank Most Worshipful Grand Master Anthony again for allowing me to try new things. Many of us have asked how can we improve on the Monday night Promenade Ball. On a visit to District #9 Past Grand Master Andrew Morgan and his staff answered that question; "Give the people what they want, a fun time". I requested and was given permission to put on the first Motown Review ever at our Grand Session, named "Showtime at Grand Session" Please come out and laugh, sing, kick up your heels and get down to the Motown sounds.


