## Antonio D. Graham

Grand Junior Warden

RW Antonio Graham's first Masonic exposure began as the son of RW Mack Graham Jr. RW Graham chose to follow in his father's footsteps serving as a Knight of Pythagoras in Martin Luther King Council No. 1. His Council was possibly the first KOP to attend Grand Session.

He thoroughly enjoyed his service as a Knight and to further his Masonic education. RW Antonio Graham was raised to the sublime Degree of a Master Mason on May 4, 1992, in Beehive Military Lodge No. 66 Camp Humphry Korea F&A.M Oklahoma Jurisdiction.

In February 2007, RW Graham demitted from Oklahoma Jurisdiction into Washington Jurisdiction. RW Graham joined Lee Grant Rogers Lodge No. 61 where he served as the Junior Deacon of the Lodge. From December 2008 through December 2010, he was elected to and served as the Junior Warden. That year, Lee Grant Rogers was awarded Lodge of the Year for the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Washington and Jurisdiction. RW Graham was elected and served Faithfully as Master of the Lodge for three years beginning in December of 2010.

RW Graham's Masonic journey continued when he was appointed to serve as District Deputy Grand Master for District No. 2 in July 2013 under the direction of MWGM Patrick L. Hughes Sr. RW Graham felt extremely proud that year, because Daniel "Chappie" James Lodge No. 72 was awarded Lodge of the Year while under his direction as the DDGM. MWGM Hughes awarded RW Graham District Deputy Grand Master of the Year for the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Washington and Jurisdiction as well.

The following year, MWGM Gregory D. Wraggs reappointed RW Graham to District Deputy Grand Master for District No. 2 where he continued to faithfully serve his Jurisdiction.

The roles and responsibilities of the Grand Junior Warden include overseeing the Knights of Pythagoras youth program and directing the Grand Lodge Scholarship Program. During the past two years, the Grand Lodge has awarded \$20,000 to over 20 high school and college students. The GJW maintains communication with the Junior Wardens in the Jurisdiction and ensures decorum during Lodge events when not in Session. He also serves and assists the Grand Master and represents the Grand Lodge at a variety of events. The Grand Junior Warden is the Second Vice Chair on the Grand Entertainment Committee and is charged with producing the Souvenir Journal.

RW Graham looks forward to continuing his service to the Grand Lodge of Washington & Jurisdiction.
