RW Terrell D. Hicklin is the eighth of eleven children born to the late Thomas C. Hicklin and Lucille Hicklin in Charlotte, NC in August of 1969. He graduated from Myers Park High School in 1987.

On September 24, 1987, He left home and joined the United States Army where he was stationed at Ft. Bragg, NC. There he meet a lot of brothers who were masons, and thus sparking his interest in masonry. He left Ft. Bragg, NC in June 1992 and was stationed in Erlangen, Germany. He meet members of Herman E. Bradley Military #74 in Nuremberg, Germany.

On September 6 of 1992, RW Hicklin was raised to the Sublime Degree of a Master Mason in Herman E. Bradley Military Lodge # 74, of the MWPHGL of WA. He served as the Lodge Treasurer from December 1992 to December 1993.

RW Hicklin continued his Military Career and was stationed at Ft. Lewis, WA where he demitted into James W. Davis Lodge #100 in June 1995. There he was elected to serve as the Lodge Secretary from December 1995 to December 1996. In December 1996 he was elected to serve as the Senior Warden of the Lodge and finally in December 1997 he was elected to serve as the Worshipful Master of James W. Davis Lodge #100. Under his leadership and guidance, the Lodge received Lodge of the Year in 1996, Worshipful Master of the Year and the Master Mason of the year. The Brothers were pleased with his leadership with his leadership that allowed their many accomplishments.

RW Hicklin continued his Military career by being stationed in Seoul, South Korea in February 1999. There, he became an associate member of II Corinthians Lodge #96. He served on several lodge committees, and in various positions

within the Lodge, to include Investigation Committees Chairman, and Lodge Liaison during Greek weekend fund raiser and step show.

RW Hicklin served as an Assistant District Deputy Grand Master for Booker T. Washington Lodge #91 while he was stationed in Hohenfels, Germany. He was an associate member of Booker T. Washington Lodge #91 and Awarded Assistant District Deputy of the Year Honors for District #9 during the years of 2005, 2006, 2007. He served diligently in that position and saw his lodge win Lodge of the year, and Worshipful Master of the year for District #9.

RW Hicklin returned to Ft. Lewis, WA in June 2008 where he assisted his lodge in many roles to become one of the best lodges within District #2. In December 2008 he was elected as the lodge Secretary until December 2013. In July of 2011 he was appointed to Assistant District Deputy Grand Master for District #2 and in June of 2012 he became the District Deputy Grand Master for District #2 until June of 2013.

RW Hicklin was assigned to Brunssum, Netherlands from July 2013 to July of 2015. Once again, RW Hicklin was stationed back at Ft. Lewis, WA where he served as the Lodge Secretary December 2015.

RW Hicklin has served in many other houses of Masonry. He was a member of Cascadian Consistory in June 1995, served in Zerubbabel, Chapter #61, Great Northwest Commandery #1 in June 1995, and Yemen Temple #152 October 1995. In June of 2005 he demitted to Booker T. Alexander Consistory #117 and served as the 1st Lieutenant Commander.

In 2016 RW Terrell D. Hicklin was elected to serve in the position of Grand Junior Warden for the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge (F. & A.M.) of Washington and Jurisdiction where he took on the challenge of running the Scholarship Program & all of the Youth Programs in particular the Knights of Pythagoras.

In September 2016 RW Terrell D. Hicklin retired from the United States Army as Master Sergeant and was a Brigade Senior Human Resource Sergeant and served his country for 29 years.

In 2018 he was elected to serve as the elected Grand Senior Warden and put in charge of all special projects and worked tirelessly to achieve success.

In 2019 he received his last and final degree, 33rd and styled Grand Inspector General in the Scottish Rite Annual Session in Philadelphia, PA.

RW Hicklin is married with four children, and one grandchild. He served as a youth Football Coach in Spanaway, WA for the Spanaway Sentinels. He also is life member in the Veterans of Foreign Wars in Tacoma, WA. He works hard, and chooses to spend his free time giving back to the community.
